5. 진행결과 보고내용

※ 산·관·학 그룹별 토론의 Session 3 (“Sharing Experience In Regulatory Reforms for Rural and Urban Development”)에 대한 발표 및 토론내용을 2차 총회 시 보고한 내용임.

At the group discussion three, participants presented and discussed about the provided theme, “Sharing Experiences in Regulatory Reforms for Rural and Urban Development.” However, as the topic on the regulation is still a huge one, participants were encouraged not to confine themselves to its narrow sense. Three keynote speakers from the Philippines, Japan, and Cambodia, and one lead discussant from Myanmar led the session. Representatives from other countries also actively presented their comments during the session.

Participants touched a variety of topics, among others, land reform including the issue of land title, community development, regional settlement, processing and export of agricultural products, infrastructure, etc. Various means for narrowing gaps between urban and rural areas were also mentioned, such as legislation, shuffling of governmental organizations, establishment of national and sectoral developmental strategic plans, empowerment and human resource development, and direct support programs (e.g. Poverty Reduction Fund in Laos).

They recognized that, with regard to the agriculture and rural development, one should pay attention to the issues of both “over-regulation” and “under-regulation”; from the perspective of business opportunity of private sector, investment should be promoted through deregulation, meanwhile, considering the mostly disadvantaged circumstances of the people in rural areas, protection of rural economy and society should be secured through appropriated regulatory measures.

It came up with the conclusion that the role of the state is very crucial because of its authority to establish strategies, laws, proper public

organizations, and approach to rural development.

Finally, participants agreed that the EAF is an excellent opportunity to share information and development experiences among member countries, and therefore it is necessary to gather and accumulate them in a more systematic way, and the cyber secretariat will work as a wonderful gate of experience sharing.
